True story life of Wladyslaw Szpilman, one of the finest pianists in pre-World War II Europe. A Jewish resident of Warsaw, first he is confined with his family in the Ghetto. When his family is deported to a death camp, he is able to escape. He remains in hiding, living in refuge after refuge of ever-decreasing quality, provided by Gentile friends. He has numerous encounters with Nazis, is forced to go without food for many days at a time, and is reduced to primitive living, scavenging morsels. Barely alive, he ultimately survives through acts of kindness from a most unlikely source... Powerful film... Considered by many film critics and viewers to be the best Holocaust film ever made and ranked on the Internet Movie Database as the 47th Best Film of all time. (2½ hours)
