5767 is a SHANA P'SHUTA (12 months), FULL (both Cheshvan and Kislev have 30 days), 355 days, 51 Shabbatot, 10th year of the 304th Lesser Cycle (19-yr lunar cycle), 27th year of the 206th Greater Cycle (28-year, solar cycle), 6th year of the current Sh'mita cycle

The molad of Tishrei 5767 (unannounced) is FRI 19h 37m 6p. Since this is after 18h on Friday, we say the molad of Tishrei is on Shabbat (and before noon) so Rosh HaShana begins on Shabbat
