Kristallnacht Anniversary Double Feature

"Outcast" - Documentary revealing the Nazi persecution of Jews in Germany from 1933 until Kristallnacht in November 1938, utilizing testimony of persons who lived through it and film footage and photographs; and

"Eagles Over Auschwitz" - Film of the historic flight over Auschwitz of three Israeli F-15's in September, 2003. Meet Yitzhak Cohen, a survivor of the camp, and Al Weber, an American Jewish airman who flew over Auschwitz on a bombing mission with the US Army Air Force in 1944. (Todah rabah to VIDEOMIT for permitting us to present this moving documentary.)

Tuesday, Nov. 7, Kristallnacht Anniversary (Jewish date), 2:00pm

"Liberation" - Documentary on the parallel battlefronts of WW2 - the allies' fight to liberate the continent and Hitler's genocidal war against the Jews. Using first-person accounts, film, and radio broadcasts from the time, the film contrasts the thrill of the allied victories with the horror of the Final Solution continuing until the last days of the war.

A powerful movie, and an appropriate way to remember Kristallnacht. (1h 40m)
