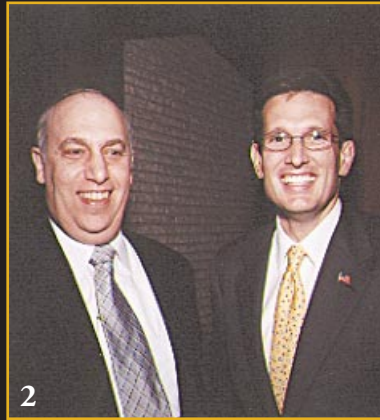


Congressman Cantor Guest Speaker at Union Society Event
